FRIDAY, AUGUST 27 | DEPART US

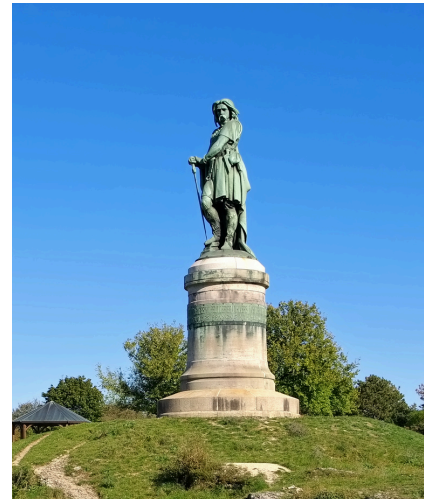
## DAY 01 SATURDAY, AUGUST 28 | OWL'S CHARM & CITÉ DELIGHTS

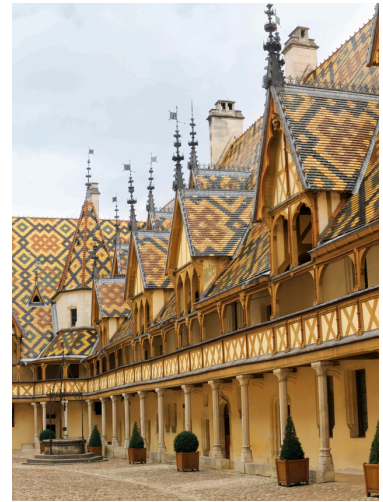




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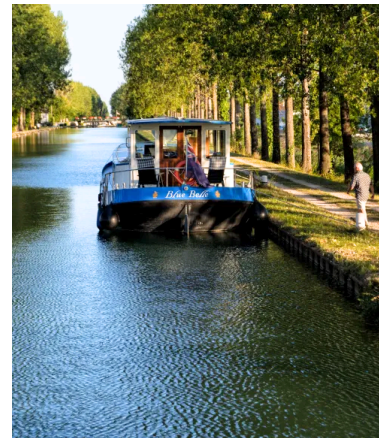
## DAY 04 TUESDAY, AUGUST 31 | BEAUNE'S HEART & VINTAGE ARTISTRY
